

President's Report

Ladies and Gentlemen this month's article I would like to reiterate a few important points that the board has tried to impress on the engineering community in the last three years. Last month I outlined the process our community needs to use to obtain special permission from the plumbing board for systems similar to rainwater reclaim system. Also our board has reported on other processes such as Elevated gas pressure permit requirements from the plumbing board. I have talked with Joe Peluso, Executive director of the plumbing board, and he has reported to me that there are still a lot of firms which are not following these guidelines. This article is a reminder to all that we need to cooperate with the plumbing board to obtain our permits. They are our partners in this process.

Having said this, I understand there are powers in all our offices that do not understand this. As the responsible party of our designs, it is all our responsibilitie to educate these people on the process. We also have to educate the people in our firms that write the proposals for our fees. This requires more time and energy to permit these jobs. So when the Project executive or Engineering managers says "we never had to do that before" it is up to each and every one of us to educate them.

I talked with Joe Peluso the other day and he told me they are also still receiving incomplete elevated gas permit applications. This is a little disheartening as Manny Garcia spent a lot of time addressing this with the board and he published the steps in this newsletter only a couple of years ago and yet there still seems to be some firms that do not want to follow this.

In closing, your board has worked very hard to try and get the information you need. We have tried to get our portion of the industry to see that these steps are needed to design buildings here in Massachusetts. It is a little disheartening to hear of all the firms which still do not follow these procedures.

Technical Report

September Technical Presentation

The September Technical presentation was very well presented by Mr. Bill Reid and Mr. Larry Whalen. The main topic was Solar Thermal Evacuated Tube Technology.

Bill Reid pointed out early in the presentation that the use of solar design is not a new field and has been around for thousands of years. There was resurgence of solar systems in the 1960 and 1970's but low energy costs post the early 1970's oil embargo had slowed the industry. Currently, energy costs have risen and improvements in technology have opened the market to the use of solar energy once again.

The solar evacuated tube system can be used for a multitude of building uses; among them are domestic water supplemental heating, radiant heating, pool water heating, etc. Incentives in the form of rebates and tax credits are off by utility companies, the Federal and State Level. There is an active database kept that you can visit to determine if you project is eligible. The website is www.desire.org.
