

Technical Report

We hope you will join us for our September Meeting. The seminar will focus on the theory and practice necessary for the design and installation of copper piping systems, utilizing non-flame joining methods. It shall include information about standards and applications of copper and copper alloy tube and fittings and the materials and steps involved in making consistent, high quality copper-to-copper joints without the use of heat or open flame. Topics discussed will cover roll grooving, press-fit, and push-connect. In addition, a short discussion related to mechanically formed extruded tees will be presented, commonly referred to as T-Drill.

Our speaker will be Dale L. Powell, a Project Manager and Piping Applications Specialist for Copper Development Association Inc. (CDA). CDA is a not-for-profit trade association that serves as the advanced market development and engineering services arm of the copper and brass industry in the United States. As such, CDA provides engineering assistance, technical development and installation training to the designers, specifiers, installers and consumers of copper and copper alloy tube and fittings.

Since 1995, Mr. Powell has managed the commercial and plumbing tube and fittings markets in the 13 Northeastern states and the District of Columbia for CDA. He has over 20 years experience in the plumbing and HVAC industry as an Estimator, Project Coordinator, Designer and Installer prior to coming to CDA. Dale is a Master Plumber, Certified Instructor of Apprentices and Journeymen with 16 years experience as an Instructor and is professionally affiliated with ICC, NFPA, NACE, AWS, ASPE, ASSE and numerous other professional organizations.
