

Technical Report

You are cordially invited to join us for our April Meeting Tuesday, April 9, 2013, at Lantana's in Randolph MA. This month's meeting is our Annual Joint Meeting with the Plumbing, Heating and Cooling Contractors of Greater Boston, better known as the PHCC. This meeting is always a great opportunity to come out and meet with our fellow Contractors and Industry professionals. These are the folks that install the systems that you specify, design and sell. Please make your reservation early as this meeting is usually well attended.

This month's seminar topic will be a 60-minute traditional, lecture-style education session in which an overview of the changes to the medical gas and vacuum system requirements in the new NFPA 99, Health Care Facilities Code, 2012 edition are discussed. In addition, a brief synopsis of the elements of a comprehensive medical gas systems operation and management program will be provided. The presentation will be followed by our usual question and answer period.

The presentation will consist of an overview of the important changes to the medical gas and vacuum system requirements in the new edition of NFPA 99 including the following:

- NFPA Definitions and Applicability of the Code
 - This is an overview of how the code has moved from the application of an occupancy-based method of the requirements to a riskbased approach.
- Central Supply System and Equipment Changes 1)
- 2) Pipeline Distribution System and Components Changes
- 3) Alarm Warning Systems Changes
- 4) Performance Criteria and Testing Changes
- Operation and Management 5)

This is a synopsis of the new requirements for the operation and management for existing medical gas and vacuum systems. After attending this session, the participant will be knowledgeable of the changes to the requirements for medical gas and vacuum systems in NFPA 99 and also be able to identify the applicable regulatory requirements for the operation and management of medical gas systems.

Our presenter is Mr. Jonathan C. Willard, the president and owner of Certified Medical Gas Services (CMGS), which is a privately held company with the vision to be a single-source, turnkey provider of comprehensive medical gas services. Jonathan has worked in the medical gas and health care construction industry for over 16 years. The countdown is on: the federal "Reduction of Lead in Drinking Water Act" becomes effective January 4, 2014, and distributors, engineers, contractors, and code officials all need to start preparing now. To facilitate a smooth transition, The Get the Lead Out Plumbing Consortium is in place and ready to get *you* ready ... offering widespread education about the manufacture, distribution, and installation of Lead Free* plumbing products.

The Consortium – a cross-section of the plumbing industry comprised of leading trade associations and manufacturers – is offering a variety of resources that will help you prepare for this new law, which will make it illegal to sell or install pipes, fittings and fixtures in applications that convey water for human consumption that have a weighted average lead content exceeding 0.25% (the previous national standard was 8.0% maximum).

"This is a game changer," says Roger Peugeot, vice chairman of the PHCC Educational Foundation. "There is a lot of stock out there in trucks and warehouses, which will need to be used by the end of [2013]. The product also takes a different technique for soldering, which will involve training."






