

February 2013 ASPE Boston Chapter Meeting Propane Gas Tank Systems Design

You are invited to join us for our February Meeting on Tuesday, February 12, 2013. The meeting will be at Lantana's in Randolph MA. The technical program offered for this meeting will be "Propane Gas Tank Systems Design". The following topics and discussions will be covered:

A summary of the increasing demand and the local increased availability of liquefied petroleum gas. The topic shall include a discussion of the latest underground and aboveground tanks and associated equipment for the design and installation of propane gas systems. LEED-certified schools do not have to cost a penny more to build than a conventional school. On average, "Green Schools" use 33 percent less energy and 32 percent less water than their conventional counterparts, and save \$100,000 per year on direct operating costs. More than 3,000 schools are LEED certified. Many of these schools, particularly those built in the last three years indicate that they have achieved LEED certification for no additional cost to the project's budget and oftentimes for a total cost that is less than regional construction costs for conventional schools built during the same time period. 


