


#### Returning Members 50% off Promotion

If your membership lapsed in 2012 (or any year prior to that), you are eligible to rejoin the Society at a 50% discount. Attached in this newsletter is the required Membership Application that you need to fill out and send in to Society with your membership payment. Regardless of how many years it has been since your membership lapsed, all it takes to become a member again is to fill out the form. You will see there is an optional section for past year's renewal also at 50% off. That optional section is for those previous members who have missed multiple membership years, and would like to retain their original ASPE membership number and membership anniversary year. Any person whose membership lapsed more than a year ago can retain their original ASPE Membership Number and uninterrupted membership status by paying 50% dues for each membership year that lapsed. If that is important to you, just fill out the application accordingly. If it doesn't matter, just fill out the form and leave the additional years section blank. # Legislative Report



What is "Special Permission" and how is it applied for? This month's Legislative article is a summary of the process and the necessary applications with the Plumbing Board.

The requirements for special permission are stated in Massachusetts State Plumbing Code 248 CMR Sections 3.02 and 3.04 (3). Special permission from the board is sought when in the boards view, a certain product, material, design method or system raises special safety considerations. Special permission is required for such products and systems as air admittance valves, gas booster pumps, combination waste and vent systems, water recycling systems, elevated gas pressure and duel fuel systems.

Products and systems requiring special permission are listed in their entirety on the board's three special permission application forms. There are separate special permission applications for Plumbing, Gas & Duel Fuel. The forms can be found on the board's website at the following location <u>http://www.mass.gov/ocabr/licensee/dpl-boards/pl/forms/applications/</u>

Please note that the board has stated that special permission is no longer required for a Sovent system even though it is listed on the current plumbing special permission application form. The board views a Sovent system as an engineered plumbing system, and defers to the proper design and compliance of the system to the engineer of record. It should also be noted that the board defines a storm water harvesting system as a gray water system; this is in conflict with ASPE's definition of gray water and has led to some confusion between plumbing engineers and the plumbing board. When applying for special permission for storm water harvesting system, gray water should be checked off on the application form.


