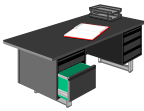

The Zero Lead Tolerance topic in our industry as presented by Dann Holmes with the National Sanitation Foundation last month was received very well indeed. The Massachusetts State Board of Examiners of Plumbers and Gas Fitters now allows for the sprinkler portion of combined NFPA 13D systems to be installed by a licensed Plumbing Contractor provided that it is integrated with the plumbing system (i.e. domestic water), that the system is designed and sealed by a registered Professional Engineer (i.e. you the PE) and that the installation is in conformance with the specific Pipe and Fitting Manufacturer's guidelines and certifications. The topic will cover both the design aspects and installation requirements. This will potentially mean a lot of work for our industry so please join us and take the opportunity to get out and socialize with our Contractor partners in the business. This is always a well attended meeting, so register early when you receive your E-Mail Notice and get that on-line discount.

A reminder to all current members: Knock Knock, Who's There. Seriously though, **we are in a membership drive right now**. As I discuss each month, membership is about taking ownership. 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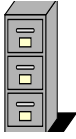

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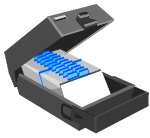

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# Legislative Report

Last February's Legislative Report was a brief summary of the Massachusetts state accessibility laws and the regulations and responsibilities of the plumbing engineer. A number of you have contacted me requesting a follow up article elaborating the plumbing engineer or designer's responsibilities. This month's Legislative Report is an attempt to answer this question.

The three main spaces of concern for the plumbing engineer in regards to accessibility are the public toilet rooms, bathing rooms and kitchens. The following is a breakdown of each space and the specific items we, the plumbing engineer, are responsible for and can control, in regards to plumbing fixture accessibility

### Toilet Rooms:

- Water closets shall be mounted at a height of 17" to 19" above finish floor. Closet seats shall not be spring loaded and are to be of open front design. The flush valve shall be hand operated or automatic. Manual flush valves shall be mounted with the handle on the wide side of the water closets area, no more than 44 inches above finished floor. Where 6 or more water closets are provided, an alternate accessible water closet shall be provided in addition to the primary accessible water closet.
- Urinals shall be a maximum of 17" above finished floor. The urinal flush valve shall be hand operated or automatic and be mounted a maximum of 44 inches above finish floor.
- Lavatories shall be mounted with the rim no higher than 34" above the finish floor. The lavatory shall extend a minimum of 17" from the wall to the front of the sink or counter. Lavatory supply and waste piping shall be insulated or guarded. The maximum lavatory bowl depth shall be 6-1/2 inches. The lavatory faucets shall be operable with one hand and may be manual or sensor operated.
- Please note that the above mounting heights requirements are for adults, children ADA mounting heights vary by age group.

### Bathing Rooms:

Shower stalls shall be 36" x 36" with no more than a 1/2" maximum curb or 30" x 60" with no curb. A folding seat is to be provided in both shower sizes. The controls shall be a single lever pressure balance mixing valve. A 36" x 36" shower stall shall have the controls located on the wall opposite to the seat. A 30" x 60" shower stall shall have the controls located on the wall adjacent to the seat. A spray shower attached to a 60" flexible metal hose and mounted to a 30" long slide bar is to be provided.

### Kitchens:

Kitchen sinks shall be mounted with the rim no higher than 34" above the finish floor. The sink depth shall not exceed 8". Sink supply and waste piping shall be insulated or guarded. The sink faucet shall be operable with one hand and may be manual or sensor operated.

The above requirements are an outline of ADA Accessibility Guidelines (ADAAG) and 521 CMR, The Rules and Regulations of the Massachusetts Architectural Access Board, both should be referenced during design and are available on line at the following addresses:

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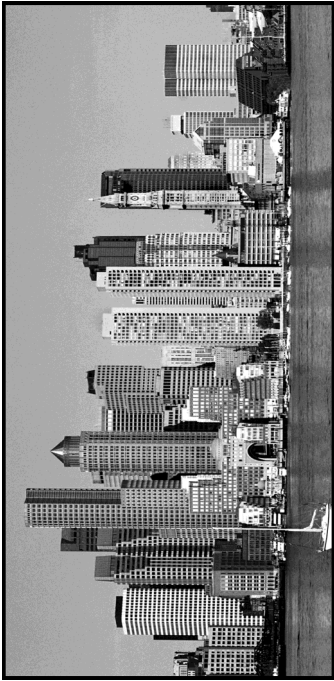
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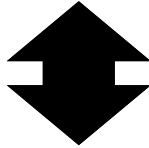
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
