



Legislative Report



This month's Legislative Report is review of the board's tentative guidelines for the installation of 13D sprinklers on potable water systems.

The Plumbing Board posted the current guidelines on October 31, 2012 and amended it on June 26, 2013. In short, the guideline requires the installation of 13D sprinkler systems, piping and sprinkler heads, to be installed by a license plumber and not a licensed sprinkler fitter. The installing plumber is to follow the design plans of the professional engineer and provide the plumbing inspector with written certification by the professional engineer that the system complies with the design. Non-plumbing permits and inspections in regards to the design and testing of the system is not the responsibility of the installing plumber. The board is aware that the Department of Public Safety taken a different position in regards to 13D sprinklers.

On May 1, 2013 the Department of Public Safety issued a memorandum stating its own policy in regards to 13D sprinkler systems. In a nutshell, the memorandum states that multipurpose piping sprinkler systems (as defined by NFPA 13D), "may be installed by a licensed plumber, exclusive of the sprinkler heads, which shall be installed by a licensed sprinkler fitter in accordance with MGL c 146 §81"

The board has stated that the tentative guidelines are still in affect and that final guidelines have yet to be drafted. The Plumbing Boards guidelines and the Department of Public Safety Policy can be found at the following locations






