

Press Technology in plumbing and mechanical systems has become a viable alternative to conventional pipe joining methods like soldering or threaded connections. The presentation will start with a brief history of piping systems followed by an overview of the latest federal regulations for materials in piping systems. Today press-connect fittings are available for multiple applications in residential, commercial and industrial piping systems. The main part of the presentation will focus on the applications, features and benefits of Press Technology and a comparison to traditional pipe joining methods like soldering and threading. In addition attendees will learn about how press fittings are tested and referenced in federal and local codes.

California Energy Commission approves stringent water appliance standards


The energy efficiency and water standards, which call for 1.28-gpf toilets, 0.125-gpf urinals, and 1.2-gpm residential lavatory faucets as of January 1, 2016, are expected to save more than 10 billion gallons of water in the first year. However, some industry groups, including PMI, IAPMO, and PHCC-National Association, are concerned about the feasibility of implementing such stringent standards as well as health and safety factors.

Legislative Report




Residential combination boilers or boilers that heat water utilized for both space heating and potable use are becoming a popular option for residential building applications. This month's legislative article will review some of the Massachusetts specific requirements in regards to residential combination boilers.

The plumbing board enacted the "Combination Space Heating / Potable Water System" policy on May 30, 2012, the policy can be found on the board's website at the following location: <u>http://www.mass.gov/ocabr/docs/dpl/boards/pl/guidelines-combination-water-system.pdf</u>

The policy details the piping and valving requirements of a combined system. The entire piping system, including the piping to the air handler is required to comply with 248 CMR and is to be installed by a licensed plumber. Since the entire system is considered to be a potable system, a backflow preventer is not required; please note that the air handler circulator pump is to be NSF-61 approved and its specification should be coordinated with the HVAC engineer. Also, the maximum developed length of piping to the air handler is limited to 100'-0", this could affect the location of the air handler and should be coordinated with the HVAC engineer. Individual manufacturers may have more stringent piping requirements than the plumbing board, the plumbing engineer should also reference the manufacturer piping requirements.
