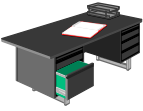

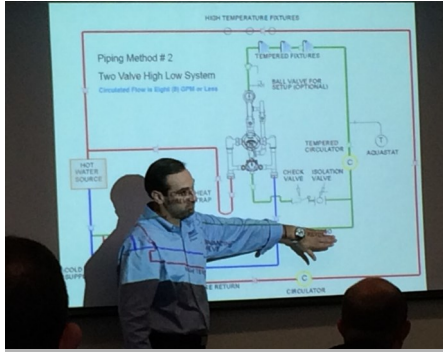

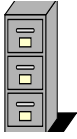

Legislative Report

When designing natural gas service to a gas fired generator, please be aware of the following requirement from NFPA 110, 2013 Edition.

Section 7.9.7 and 7.9.8 states the followings:

7.9.7 Where the gas supply is connected to the building supply system, it shall be connected on the supply side of the main gas shutoff valve and marked as supplying an emergency generator.

7.9.8 The building's main gas shutoff valve shall be marked or tagged to indicate the existence of the separate emergency power supply (EPS) shutoff valve.

My interpretation:

If a project is allowed to use a gas fired generator for life safety, the 2013 Edition of NFPA 110 requires that a dedicated gas supply line shall run to the gas fired generator.

The decision to allow the use of a gas fired generators for life safety rests on the local Authority Having Jurisdiction (building dept.)
