

Technical Report

Legislative Report

When designing and specifying a domestic water booster system in your project, you must take into consideration the energy efficiency requirements by

ASHRAE Standard 90.1-2010 Section 10.4.2

ASHRAE 90.1 Section 10.4.2 reads the following:

10.4.2 Service Water Pressure Booster Systems.

Service Water Pressure Booster Systems shall be designed such that:

> One or more pressure sensors shall be used to vary pump speed and/or start and stop pumps. The sensor(s) shall either be located near the critical fixture(s) that determine the pressure required, or logic shall employed that adjusts the set point to simulate operation of remote sensor(s)

No device(s) shall be installed for the purpose of reducing the pressure of all of the water supplied by any booster system pump or booster system, except for safety devices.

No booster system pumps shall operate when there is no service water flow.
